Students have access to specialist Vocational lessons on site including Horticulture, Catering and Facilities Management. Students also access external work placements in the community supported by an employability coach. We expect most students to work towards becoming independent travellers.

We would love to hear from teachers with an experience in special education, who have the desire and motivation to make a difference in our students' lives. It would be desirable to have some experience or a keen interest in the field of catering or food preparation. We believe that all of our students are capable of making outstanding progress and we want to appoint individuals who share our beliefs.
